

SUMMARY SHEET

I. Description of Item

This item approves a contract with Standard Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$3,152,761.00 for asphalt repaving of ten roadway segments in Shelby County that have been selected for overlay due to conditional issues. A new pavement surface will improve rideability and visibility with new pavement markings. The project is being funded using \$3,086,706.00 of grant funds from the Tennessee Department of Transportation and \$63,055.00 from the Roads and Bridges Fund for the required match.

The selected roadway segments must be on the TDOT State-aid list of roads to be eligible for funding. The State-aid Roadway Maintenance Program was amended to allow a ninety-eight percent (98%) reimbursement. The (98/2) reimbursement program is a temporary two year measure to assist counties with needed roadway paving maintenance and that amendment will expire in June 2017. The State-aid grants historically have been a 75/25 matching program.

II. Source and Amount of Funding

This project is being funded through the TDOT State-Aid Program per attached Exhibit B. The local required match amount of \$63,055.00 is being provided through the Roads and Bridges Fund.

IV. **Other Relevant Information**

The contractor has committed to utilize locally owned small business subcontractors for 7% of the total contract.

Ten roadway segments have been proposed for resurfacing for a total of approximately 21.0 linear miles as follows:

1. Pleasant Ridge/Jack Bond Road from Highway 204 to Brunswick Road.
2. Ward Road from Old Millington Road to Russell Bond Road.
3. New Bethel Road from West Union Road to the Shelby-Tipton County Line.
4. Bethuel Road from Mudville Road to Millington City Limits.
5. Berryhill Road from Macon Road to the City of Memphis Limit.
6. Houston Levee Road from Walnut Grove Road to the Wolf River Bridge.
7. Cuba Millington/Shelby Road from River Bluff Road to Woodstock Cuba Road and Shake Rag Road to Epp Mill Road.
8. Robertson Road/Fite Road from Roberston Road to Raleigh Millington Road.
9. Redwood Road from Brunswick Road to Deadfall Road.
10. Monterey Road from Reid Hooker Road to Collierville-Arlington Road.
